INFORMATION AND UPDATES

- HHS has issued a new HSPPS outlining the masking and COVID-19 vaccination requirements. <u>The Interim Final Rule with</u> <u>Comment Period</u> is posted in the Federal Register with a link to submit formal comments. You can read a summary of the requirements <u>here</u>.
- As you prepare for <u>monitoring</u> in the coming year, OHS understands the difficulties regarding enrollment and urges programs to focus on having systems in place and to keep good documentation about issues with enrollment (i.e. staffing, COVID, etc.)
- If your program has experienced staff shortages or other events that effect your expenditures, please discuss your budgets and any unused funds with your program and grant specialists to request a budget modification or extension.
- Providing virtual/remote services due to COVID/staffing/weather is allowed as a temporary option.
- Programs will not be penalized for not meeting the minimum days of service and will not be required to make up those days. Make sure you fully document the reasons for missed days.
